HAND OVER SPEECH BY BWAMBALE DAVID KONGOLO AT RWEFRA OFFICES IN BUKOTO DATED THE 12TH DAY OF JUNE 2021:

put myself at the fore front of financial matters. Our outgoing trusted Secretary General Sam Kiriaghe is in charge of this. We shall work hand in hand with you to make sure this is a realized. The reason we have not paid is that the entire chuck of land is sold as one solid block of 48 acres. My assurance to you is that we are almost there.

- 4. A member called Uben offered Rwefra an office space in Kasese Municipality. Kindly follow it up as it is part of our agenda to have physical presence in most of the districts in the Rwenzori region.
- 5. The audited accounts. The accounts as promised during the AGM are out. These must be presented in the GA for debate and approval.

Liabilities and Assets.

We have no known debt as Rwefra. The assets and all what we have as Rwefra are all in the report of the treasurer which will be handed over to you.

I thank you Mr President and all those who participated in the last campaigns that we had. We thank God they all ended smoothly. I took notice of the good ideas that were flowing from all those who shared their manifestoes with us the members. Indeed, Rwefra is gifted with brilliant people. My request and prayer is that take time to internalize those ideas and see how you can purge them together with your own ideas for the benefit of the association.

Do not also hesitate to contact the vision bearers of those ideas for their smooth implementation if adopted.

I also thought it important that I should leave you with some advice. It is just advisory the onus is purely yours to take or leave.

- 1) Be afraid to fail. I know most people have said to you do not be afraid to fail. Please ignore that advise. You should be afraid of failure that you are willing to do anything to succeed.
